ROMANESCO

BT: CAULIFLOWER [B1094] ; BROCCOLI [B1443]

SYN: romanesco broccoli ; romanesque cauliflower ; brassica oleracea botrytis

AI: Brassica oleracea L. convar. botrytis (L.) Alef. var. italica Plenck [EuroFIR Nettox No.: 53]

AVOCADO [B1470]

BT: FRUIT USED AS VEGETABLE [B1006] -> add BT: OIL-PRODUCING PLANT [B1017]

POPPY [B1515]

BT: OIL-PRODUCING PLANT [B1017] -> add BT: EDIBLE SEED PRODUCING PLANT [B1174]

for discussion:

PULSE OR PULSE PRODUCT (EUROFIR) [A0831]

SN: Use for crops harvested as dry seed. Index green beans and green peas as vegetables.

VIET NAM [R0479]

either add "vietnam" to Synonyms or change spelling to "VIETNAM" (and add "viet nam" as synonym)

JUMBO SQUID

SOURDOUGH ADDED [H0752] triggers H0319 (WHEAT ADDED) => please REMOVE this trigger, because sourdough is not always on wheat, can be on rye or rice (especially in gluten-free products)! The Scopenote is enough.
